

Synopsis

Set in a dystopian future, MISBEGOTTEN is a saga that follows the journey of a warrior priest sent to rescue a Jesus-clone from being sacrificed during a mock Passion play. ISSUE 3: Flanked by his four femmes fatales, Sir Gottfrey arrives aboard Domus Mariae in search of Double-M 091, his prodigal daughter. In the ensuing brawl, Father Micon takes the bullets intended for Elano and dies in his disciple's arms, while Gottfrey gets his lungs-box pierced. Back on Harlequin Island, Brother Ziggy, a Sigmund Freud-replika-turned-monk, takes a batch of runaway replikas to the rendezvous point with the Franciscans' submarine. J-Clone finally gets reunited with Double-M 091, only to be rushed back to the surgery table for a second Bible neuro-implant. Gottfrey gets a new pair of lungs. Seeking both revenge for his mentor's death and J-Clone's capture, Elano travels aboard the submarine to the rendezvous point and persuades Ziggy to give him passage. Once inside the ghetto, Elano stumbles into the crossfire between two gangs fighting over the vials of human blood he carries with him, and ends up a prisoner in Klaudette's personal Zoo. This is the third installment in a four-part series to be compiled in the first volume of MISBEGOTTEN. All four issues will first be released on Kindle. The saga continues and Voghan reigns in the craziness a bit: the reuniting of Double-M 091 and the Jesus clone, Father Micon takes a bullet, and several plot lines which seemed somewhat random in the last issue start go somewhere. It's still a little madcap and there is probably too many plots in too little space, but it is seeming going somewhere interesting and seems more coherent than the last issue made it seem.

Voghan delivered once again. There was a lot of story given in this issue only thickening the plot. I can't wait to see what next....

I have read the first and second issues of Runaway Nun: Misbegotten and out of the two of them this one is better than the first, but not better than the last because with my personal preference I enjoy the fighting with a story more than just, straight story. That being said this Issue does a great job of progressing the story even further and leaving me wanting to know what will happen to our hero who has found himself in a "hell for humans". And I just got to say that the addition of someone important dying really gives you the excite of the hero going on a vengeance spree rather than just a rescue mission. Can't wait to see how the story progresses!

Misbegotten returns for its third issue, continuing the long and epic cyber/biopunk post apocalyptic epic. While I will miss Justin Case's art style, Bailey does a great job of bringing the world to life and making every bit of ultra violence pop. I have to say though, for all the series' harsh and offensive character, this issue does break away from the norm by taking a bit of a narrative detour that I'm sure will be paid off with even more gore and a bigger mess than ever. Looking forward to issue 4 already.

Another strong issue in this excellent series. It picks up right where the last issue left off and doesn't slow down for a second. I think this is a little bit of a detriment, as events that feel as though they should be more significant - the reuniting of Double-M 091 and the J-clone and the death of Father Micon - don't seem to get their due treatment before moving to the next scene. That said I still left the issue ready for more, so I say mission accomplished. I can't wait for the next one!

This is a great comic series. I'm very enthusiastic about the "weird" world of famous clones and religious groups fighting for morality and right/wrong. The artwork is great and the storytelling is very appealing to me. I am very curious to see how it plays out in issue 4. Super gaaf stripboek!
