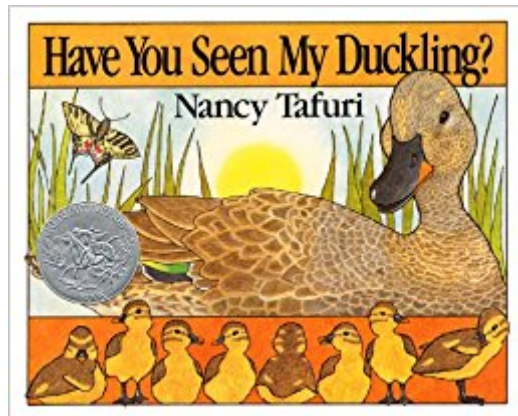




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Have You Seen My Duckling?

This is one of my favorite books for little ones! The illustrations are so beautiful and the simple story is so much fun for me to read to my granddaughter. She delights in pointing out the missing duckling

in each picture because Grandma just can't seem to find him! This book will always remind me of those special times we were together, snuggling and giggling while we read....

Not really a traditional children's book and not a picture book...don't know how to categorize it. Only a couple of pages have anything written on them so you have to make up the story yourself. Some people might like that feature...I prefer to have something written on each page.

This is a fun book that seems to really encourage story telling. The story is told through pictures, with only a little bit of text, and that seems to encourage me to embellish the story for my daughter in a different way every time. The pictures are really beautiful, and we love how the missing duckling is hiding somewhere on each page - my 18 month old has so much fun finding the missing duckling!

The pictures tell most of the story in this book, which is fun for littles who can't read yet, but want to pretend that they can. My 2 year old loves asking the question, "have you seen my duckling?" to each animal and then searching the pond for the little lost duck in each picture. We also count the ducks on each page, which is fun counting practice for her.

It is so much fun having my class of 1 year old's look for the duckling.
