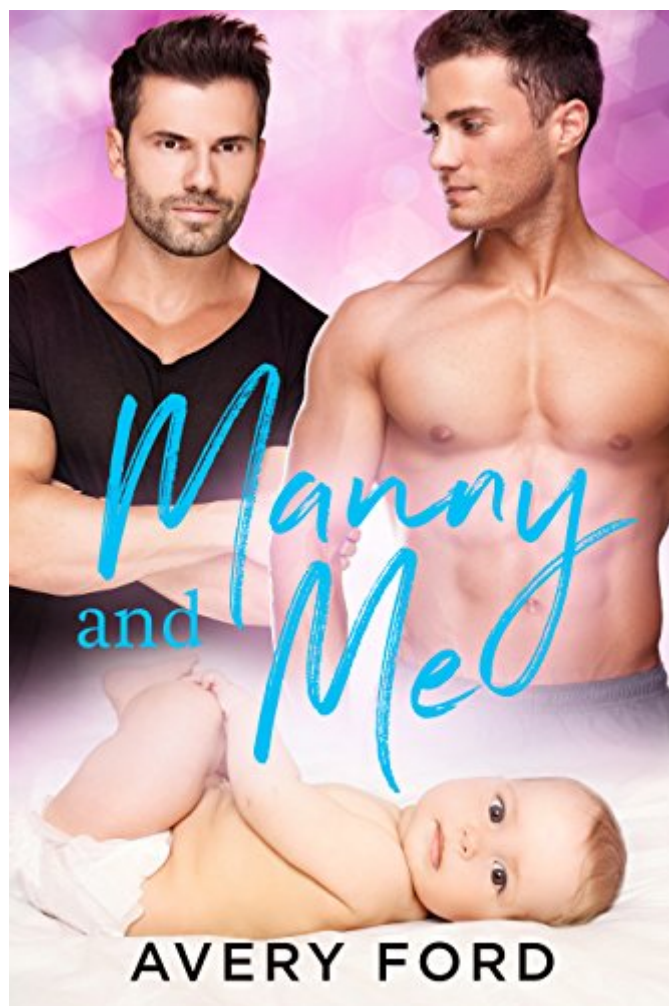

I enjoyed this book. I don't know why I went into this expecting it to be a shifter romance [slightly implying mpeg] but this is just a regular good ol' romance. It centers around Sebastian, a recent graduate that is looking to become more respectable and not have multiple sugar daddies on the side. Instead he starts working for Douglas, a recent father whose planned nanny moves away at the last second and leaves him in the lurch. The angst between the two men was cute and pulled at my heartstrings - but there were times that I got super frustrated with how obstinate the two were being. How hard is it to say that you like someone and NOT eavesdrop onto conversations and misunderstand what you hear? Ugh... Also, this book had a smattering of moments with baby Ian. Sometimes, I feel like reading a book that is more focused on the child - this wasn't the case with this book. Yes, there were moments that included Ian, but it wasn't baby-focused in any way whatsoever. This is a quick and summery read, but nothing that is very serious. I feel like the cover is a fair representation of what to expect in the book. Although I can't say that Sebastian being shirtless is a "thing" in this book. Slightly misleading...

Douglas is a new father to baby Ian (by surrogate) and is looking for a new nanny as he has to go back to work in 3 months. Sebastian is looking for a job whilst he a qualified Accountant any job at the moment would be good. He applies to be a nanny for Douglas and upon getting the job he is totally smitten with Douglas but he believes that nothing can happen between them as Douglas is his boss and he needs this job. They finally connect and then Sebastian gets scarred after their first night together with the way Douglas looks at him the morning after. Will they be able to work things out because Sebastian is totally in love with baby Ian and his Daddy.

This was a sweet and romantic story. The two main characters were misguided in their feelings but came around in the end. Douglas's cousin Kenneth needed a kick in the you know what and I know I am not the only one that would have love to know he got what was coming to him. I feel the story was a little unfinished. That's why 4 stars.

Douglas had his lifelong dream fulfilled when he became a father but after three months paternity leave he has to find a nanny for his son, Ian. Sebastian, a newly grad, needs a job fast but accountants are not hired anywhere. Working for Douglas is the perfect solution for both problems. Avery Ford has done a great job in creating the characters. Douglas is the older, devoted father; Sebastian is young and sometimes a bit naïve. The difference between their ages and

stations in life is well described. I could really feel the attraction and connection between the two men. The tension is built up nicely and I was waiting for the first kiss. It still came up unexpectedly. There are some surprising twists. It is funny, sometimes smoking hot and really engaging. Sebastian and Douglas don't have an easy journey before they really are together. Sebastian's past comes interfering with Douglas's job but I loved how they kept communicating and were there for each other. Sebastian's best friend, Gabriel, has a lot to do with this and I found him a charming, funny character whose presence really enhances the story. I loved the epilogue with little Ian in a prominent role. Swoon worthy. If you are looking for a sweet, sexy and fun read you really should give this book a try.

Manny and Me is a lite hearted story of Sebastian and Douglas. Douglas has a new son that needs a nanny and Sebastian is fresh out of college and needs a job, any job for right now. At the interview they hit it off right away. Only problem is that they have this instant connection that neither can shake and Sebastian has secrets. Love finally happens and then one of Sebastian's former closet problems shows up. That is all you are getting. This is another great book by Avery and so well worth the reading time so grab a cup of tea or coffee and set down to totally enjoy your afternoon with this little gem.

Sebastian is fresh out of college and having trouble finding a job in accounting so he takes a job as a live in nanny to a single dad, Douglas.
