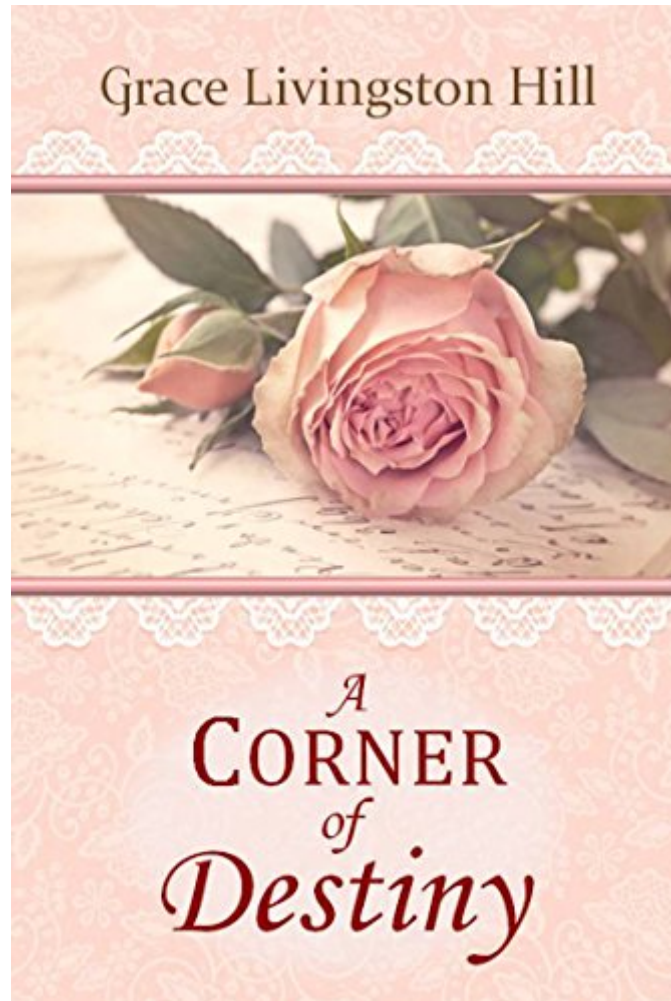




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A Corner Of Destiny

This is one of my favorite authors. I love how the "gentler" stories and this is one. You want the lead

characters to have a good and Godly life together regardless of the barriers put in their way. A Corner of Destiny is a nice story. I admit to balking a bit to pay \$3 for a short story however I knew Aunt Crete's Emancipation (another by Grace Livingston Hill) was an all-time favorite Keeper so anticipated another of the same ilk. The story-line, a busy young man inadvertently causes a young woman to hurt herself, lose her job, etc. Basically, Rosalie is a wonderful daughter working in the "big city" to help support her widowed mother. Her life is difficult and she is just barely keeping her head above water. Then, calamity -- a broken ankle prevents her from working, and the world starts to cave in upon her. The hero, Pemberton (don't you love that name?) comes to realize she's a wonderful gal. Rosalie is Real. She's not some artificial society gal and he falls for the gal he injured. His mom is against anything that does not reek of money or privilege. Ditto most of the rest of his family. There is however an older aunt (Aunt Faith) who plays a pivotal role in the tale. Anyway, that's the basics. Why Four instead of Five stars? Well, the story is quite emotional for me, and I rather prefer less tears. That's not to say I won't read it again. A Corner of Destiny is a Keeper. However, for this story you'll want to have tissues handy. Oh, and one more thing: The story did not feel "short" though I would have liked to have known the relationship between Rosalie's dad and Pemberton's father -- if there was one that is!

This is another of Grace Livingston Hill's typical Christian-based romance stories, which are all such gems and treasured by me. She's an author whose books can thankfully still be found and read. In this case, the book falls between a short story and a full-length one; I wanted there to be more. It was a completely wonderful story and makes you wish we could return to times when love between a man and a woman was pure and celibate until after marriage. I was so glad to find this "new" story since I already have nearly everything that Mrs. Hill has written. In fact, a couple of my hardback books were printed the late 1890s!
