

He joined NASA, braved an injury that nearly left him permanently deaf, and still managed to muster the courage and resolve to travel to space on the shuttle Atlantis to help build the International Space Station. Lelandâ 's problem-solving methods and can-do attitude turned his impossible-seeming dream into reality. Lelandâ 's story introduces readers to the fascinating creative and scientific challenges he had to deal with in space and will encourage the next generation of can-do scientists to dare to follow their dreams. A former wide receiver for the Detroit Lions, Leland Melvin is an engineer and NASA astronaut. He served on the space shuttle Atlantis as a mission specialist and was named the NASA Associate Administrator for Education in October 2010. He also served as the cochair on the White Houseâ™s Federal Coordination in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Education Task Force, developing the nationâ™s five-year STEM education plan. He is the host of the Lifetime show *Child Genius* and a judge for ABCâ™s *BattleBots*. He holds four honorary doctorates and has received the NFL Player Association Award of Excellence. He lives in Lynchburg, Virginia.
