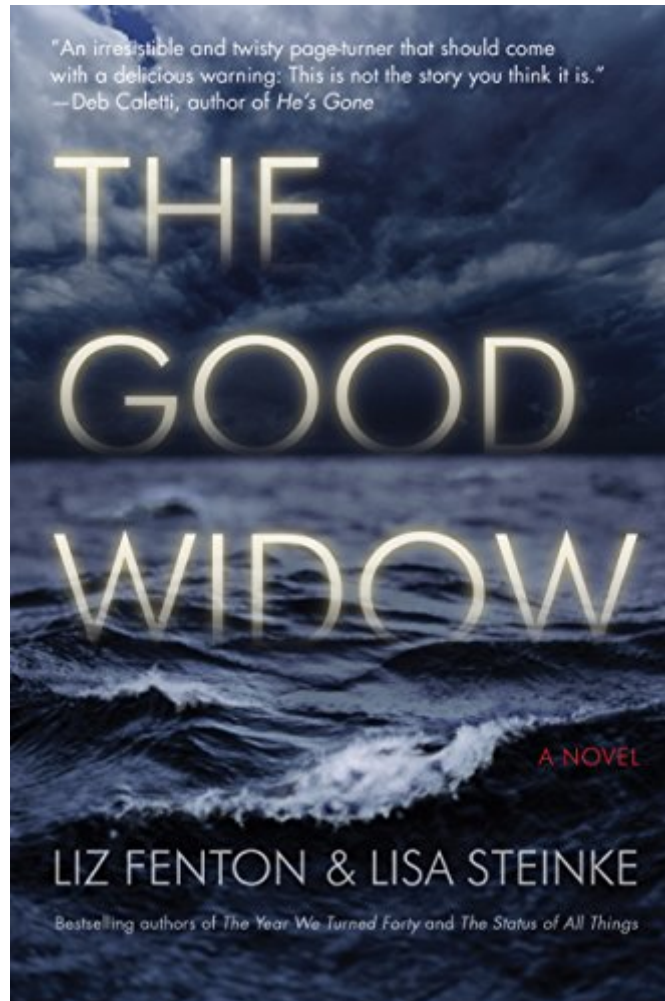




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The Good Widow: A Novel

I didn't read any of the blurbs for this book so had no idea what it was about. At first, I thought it a bit boring but it didn't take long for it to take hold. Jacqueline "Jacks" Morales is left reeling with the news that her husband James is dead after his car tumbles off a cliff in Maui. Worse yet, his death uncovers an affair with a woman named Dylan, who also died in the Jeep along with James. Caught in a tailspin of emotion, Jacks shuts down until she gets a surprise visit from Nick, Dylan's equally devastated fiancé, who suggests they seek closure by retracing James and Dylan's steps in Maui. There is much more to this story that will have you turning the pages till you reach the end. There are a lot of unexpected twists and turns in this book. If you enjoy mystery and growth, friendships and family, you will enjoy this book. A 4.5 for a well written novel.
