

Our family is a huge fan of the National Geographic Kids books, especially these early reader

books. My son is 4.5 and is probably in between level 1 and 2 reading range so these books are perfect for him. The first two he can read pretty well on his own, and the second two we work on together. These books have FULL COLOR PAGES, jokes that my son loves, and new words are defined at the bottom of the pages they appear. What I really love about the collection books is that they are a lot cheaper, especially on sale. Not to mention, less books to keep track of and store. And they're more durable than the individual books.

I read this out loud to my 3 year old. She has learned a lot and even likes the quizzes at the end of the stories. There is a lot of excellent information in this book and is presented in a way a child can understand. I also think an older child who is learning to be an independent reader would enjoy this. I love that it defines and pronounce difficult vocabulary words!

We own quite a few of the national geographic readers and we love them all. They are appropriately laid out for young readers, my daughter loves the riddles/jokes and she loves learning interesting facts about the animals and sharing them with the family. I am very pleased with this purchase and will continue to buy others in the series.

My 3 1/2 year old son loves this. Great photos and eye catching design. I think he will enjoy this for years.

I love the books in this series, and this particular collection is no exception. The pages are colorful, the jokes are kid-appropriate (so not really funny for most adults, but no problem there!), the topics are appealing, and the information is presented in a clear way. With four titles in one, this is a great value as well.

Books are combined into 1 book, rather than 4 separate.

This is a great little book to go with my ocean habitat study. It has some challenging questions for kids to share with their parents, too.
