I liked the overall story although the end was a little hurried. Character development was really good and the plot was quick. My only complaint is the massive amount of death in the major characters. I understand war is hell and that people die. However, I don't think that almost all should have to die to bring that point home. I believe in hope and if everyone is dead, what's the point of the story? Also, the main antagonist seems a bit confused, story-wise. First it's money and his brother and then the company's interests that he's working towards. With those in mind, I still liked the story telling. Hopefully future stories will be more cohesive and hopefully. Highly recommend.

While I will admit that the ending seemed just a tad truncated to me, the story is a great read.

I was read the short story that was so good, it led to this book. I was not sure about this book, since so many female heroes are just not believable. This character was believable to my pleasant surprise. With genetic engineering and/ nano machines a skilled writer can eliminate this issue, unfortunately most don't. The story flowed and was a good addition to the 4 Horseman Universe. The story kept me in suspense and had plots within plots, but not so convoluted I lost track. A mode of failure of an item sounds like the author had had done experience with quirky issues, which happen all too often in the real world. The characters were well done, and not cardboard characters. I would appreciate a glossary in 4 horseman books so I can keep the characteristics of the species straight.

I was allowed to read an advanced copy of this book. It is thoroughly enjoyable, some interesting plot twists. It gives us a look at a non mercenary guild and some contract law on a large scale, which I found enjoyable. We see some goos interpersonal conflicts with and among aliens, giving some of them a more realistic and "alive" feel to me. I recommend this, as well as the first five books in the four horseman universe. I am impatiently, and selfishly waiting for more!!

The author does a great job keeping me glued to the story. I found myself at work using my breaks to read even more in my Kindle phone app! Jess is an engaging character who I was cheering on as Earth's first, although greatly challenged, Peacekeeper. I hope we more of her. Great book!

The author writes great combat scenes (be sure to check out RUNS IN THE FAMILY), but I found the Peacemaker's mission even more interesting, as it highlighted the very real challenges faced by an outside agency in providing acceptable solutions to multiple competing interests. I can't wait to see what Jessica's next mission will be ...

This is another entry in the new universe of the four horsemen. We get a look at one of the other interplanetary organizations in the universe and one of the few with enforcement power. The plots are interconnected and interesting. There is a lot to read here. I've read everything in this universe and this is a worthy addition. I haven't bought it yet but will soon.
