

I agree with some of the other reviews... this is by far the worst textbook I have ever read. I don't think anybody proofread or edited it. The discussion of topics within the chapters is all over the place. It doesn't have a nice flow at all. There are many discrepancies within the material and some of the information is just plain wrong. Some of the quiz questions at the end of the chapters are matched with the wrong answer. All of this makes it very difficult to learn the material. I find myself referencing other text books or looking things up on the internet just to double check the book's material and to gain a better understanding of what is being covered. This book is not worth your

time or money.

I thought the text was easy to follow. The typos are typical in the early editions of textbooks. It is succinct and straight forward. The author took care to make it easy on the eyes and not super heavy or needlessly thick.

If you are truly serious about learning hematology for practical application, get a real textbook and leave this starter one for others.

This text is not well written. At times it gives an adequate discussion of the material and at other times, it is very lacking. sometimes the end of chapter questions and discussion within the chapter do not line up. If you can avoid it, I do NOT recommend this text.
