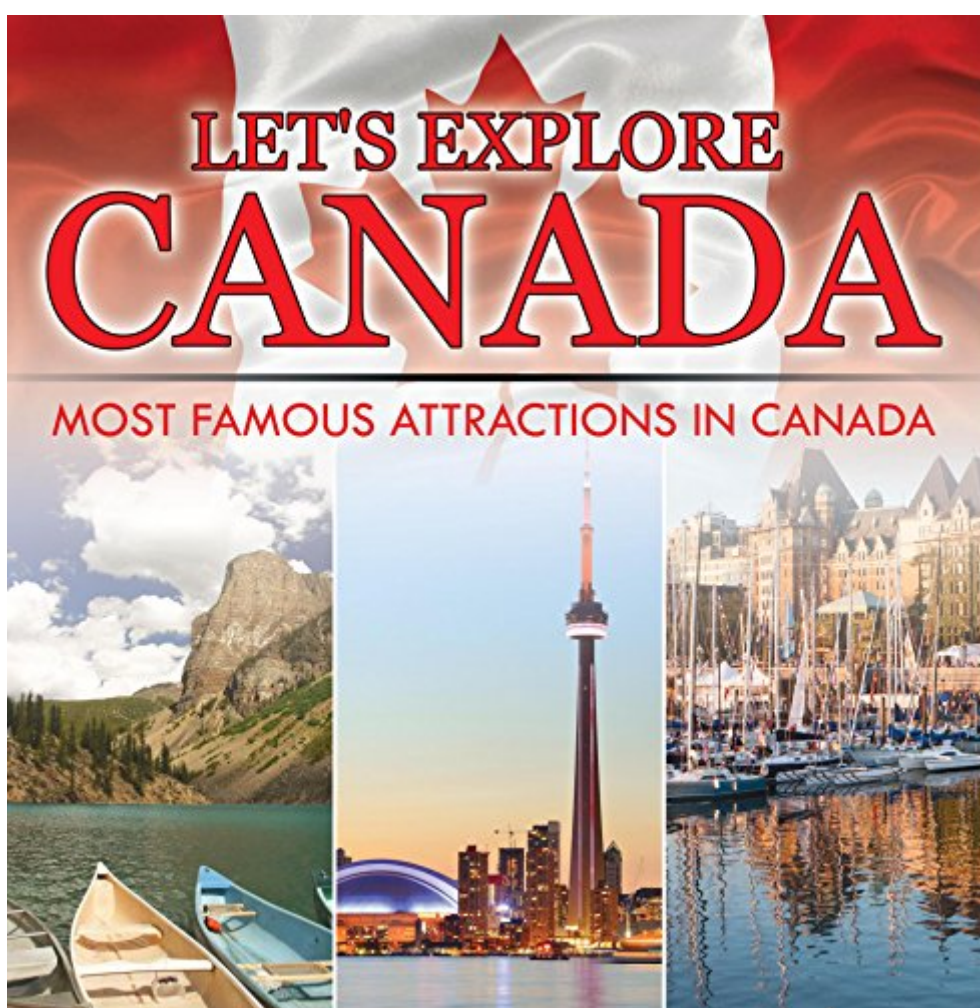


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Let's Explore Canada (Most Famous Attractions In Canada): Canada Travel Guide (Children's Explore The World Books)
