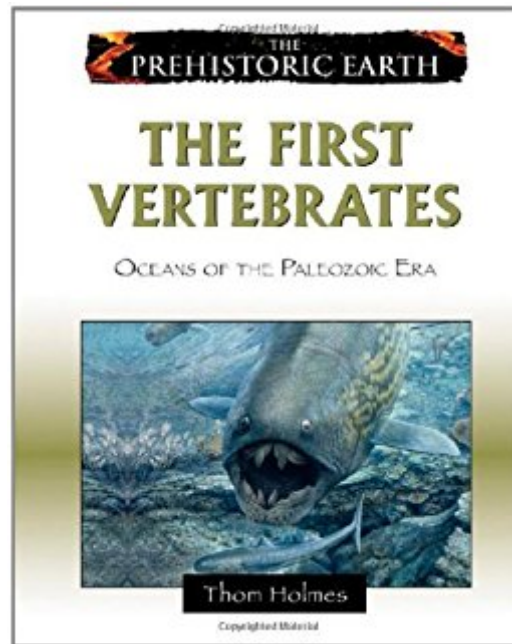


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The First Vertebrates: Oceans Of The Paleozoic Era (The Prehistoric Earth)
