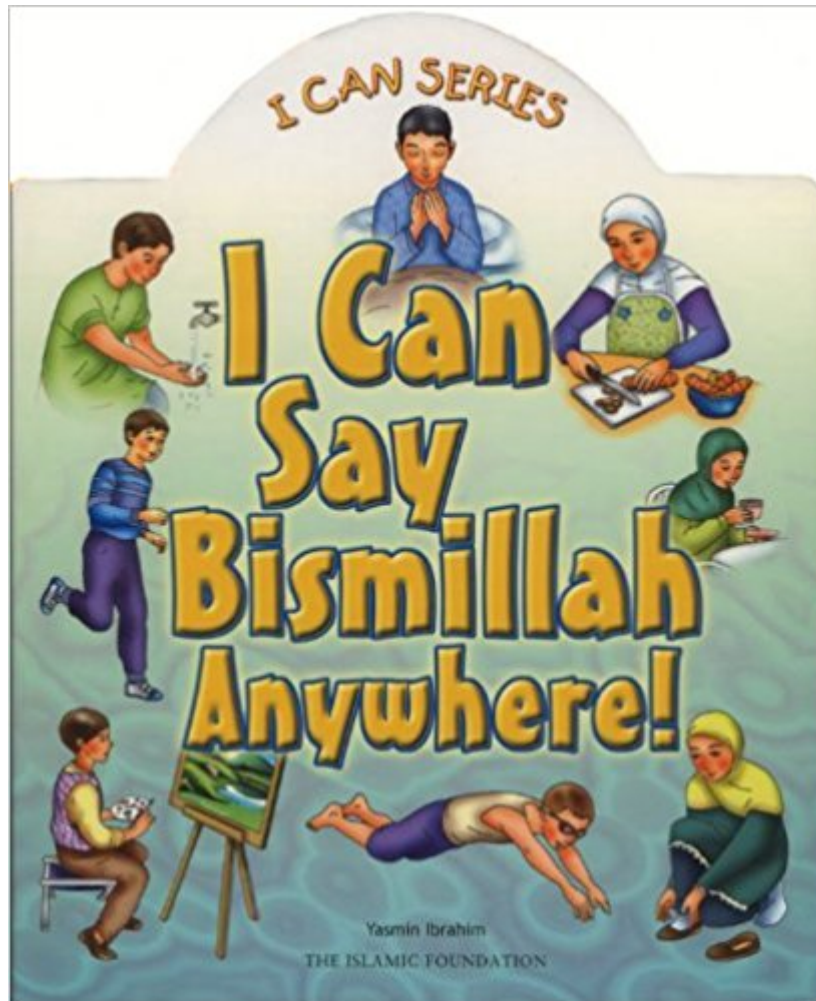

I also appreciate that the characters wear proper hijab (boys and girls).

This book was fun to read because it uses rhymes and kids can fill in the blanks as an adult reads with the help of pictures. It is durable because it's a board book and thus makes it easy to turn for little pages hands. Most importantly, through vivid almost life-like pictures it makes it easy for children to relate to the scenarios and circumstances where one should say 'Bismillah'.
