It is not rushed but a steady read. There were several times when I laughed (okay, cackled!) out loud! The author develops this story so well that you feel like you are there, witnessing the lives of those involved. You can almost hear the waves lick the shore, the birds singing, hear the dogs growling and barking, struggle with Len as he tries to communicate with others, feel Mart's panic as

he searches for Andrea and feel Andrea's desperation as she tries to hide Birdie. And, is the dog really dead? I listened to the Audible version of this book and that makes the story come to life. This book is told in the two-person formula. Usually, I am not fond of that but it does work here. I highly recommend this book which can be read by anyone who is a teen on up.

The story line was very good and I liked the way the author switched voices, back and forth between Andrea and Mart. I thought it moved very slowly throughout most of the book, and was easy to put down (not a desired characteristic of a good book!) until the very end. What most disappointed me though was finding this book listed under "Christian Fiction" and yet there little mention of God, faith or walking with the Lord through our problems until the very end. There wasn't even any real wrestling with the Lord to indicate there was a spiritual battle going on. It felt like the faith/God part was tacked on at the very end to justify it being called Christian Fiction. I was disappointed and am now hesitant to read other books by this author.

Another great book by Lisa Wingate. I love her books and this one did not lower my expectations. It's exciting to read how a couple can be drawn together to search for answers about a little girl. I was delighted to read this book and had a hard time putting it down. You will love Mart, Andrea and the little girl.
