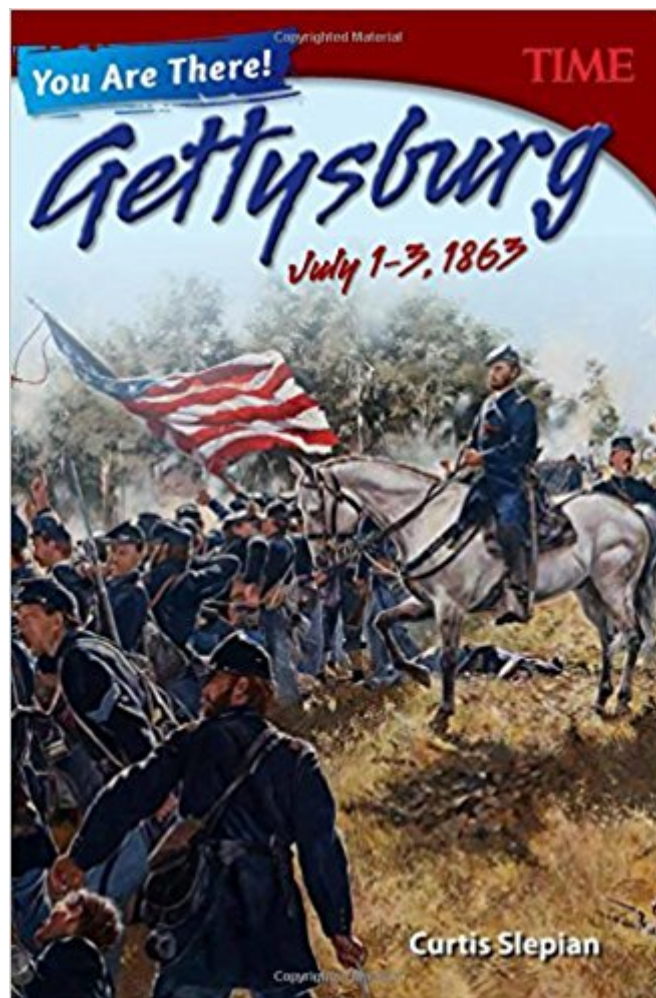




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You Are There! Gettysburg, July 13, 1863 (Grade 8) (Time For Kids Nonfiction Readers)
