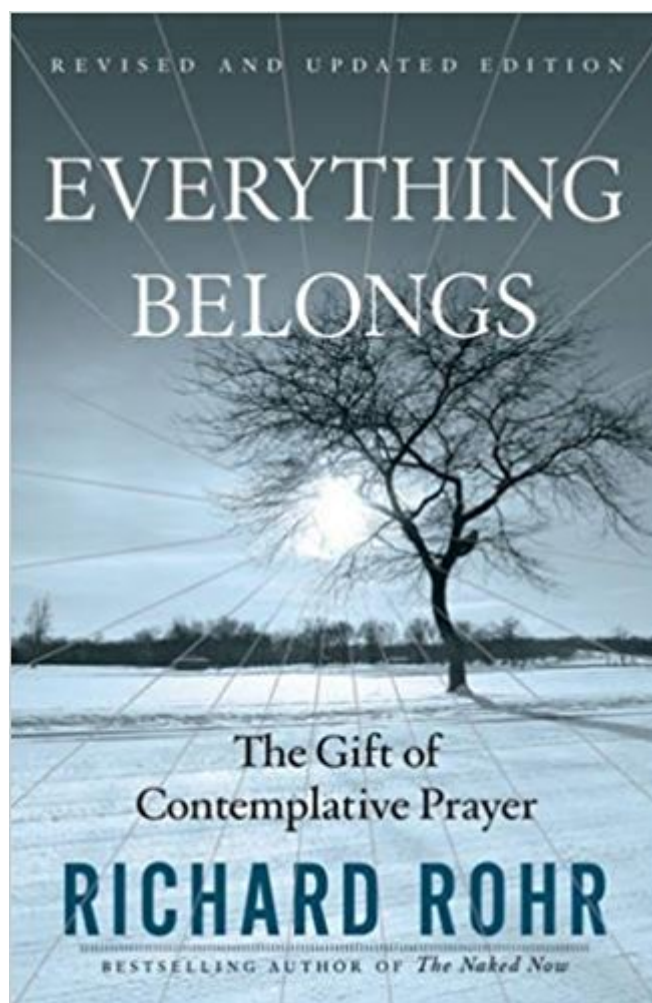

Richard Rohr lives in Albuquerque, NM, USA, where he is co-founder of the Center for Contemplation and Action. His other bestsellers include *Everything Belongs* and *The Enneagram* (the latter with sales of over 250,000 worldwide).

If you are wondering how to square your thoughts with all the religions and their variations with the practical world and your need for some connection to the real God this may be your book. Rohr is a master at reconciling conflicting ideas. Rohr is a Catholic Priest but do not let that put you off, he

has studied in the East and really has a gift for teaching. Very helpful to me, a poor follower of Jesus and a disappointed Christian.

If this title interests you, you will find what you hoped for inside. Richard Rohr is one of few authors whose books I do not need to look into to know I want to read them - any of them.
