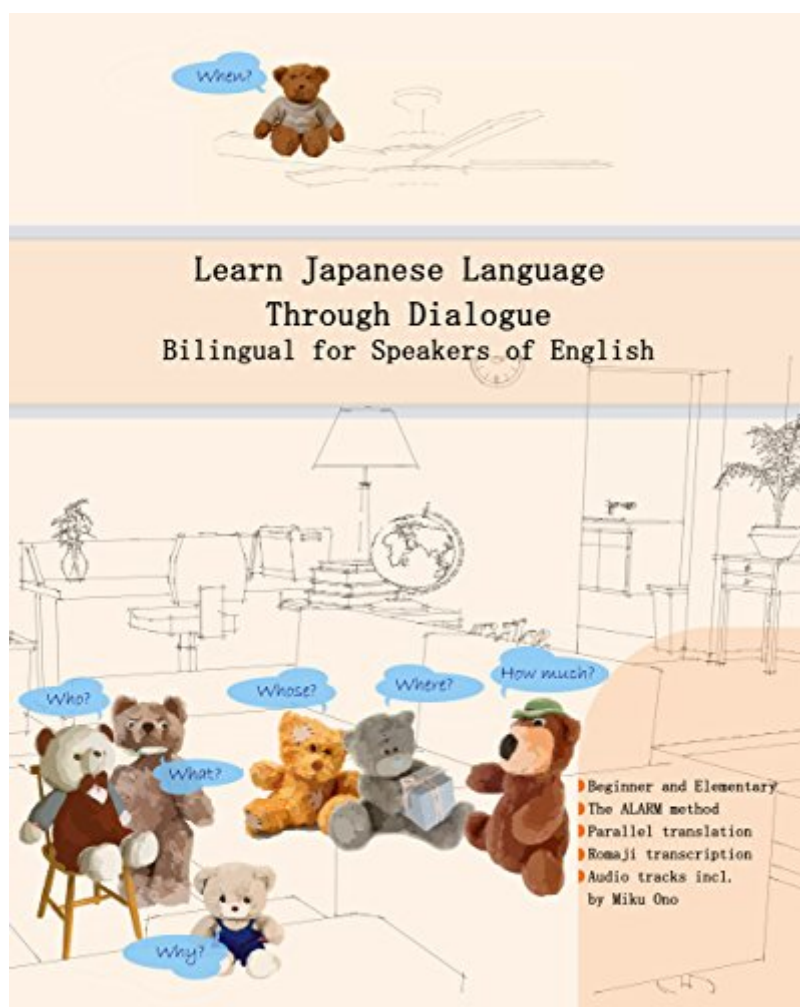

I have a degree in Japanese studies so I was excited to have a chance to read this book (sent to me by the publisher) in exchange for my honest review. I found myself quite disappointed. I loved that there was an extensive vocabulary list at the beginning of each section. Not only were there words but a few phrases as well. Then came a paragraph written in Japanese with romaji and English next to it. This would be helpful for people who can't read the characters but it would have been nice if there were superscript hiragana characters written in over the kanji. The English

translation was funny at times. It wasn't natural. Also, To go searching through the English/Romaji translations to find one thing you might not have understood was hard. The format of this could be better to make it easier to switch between the three. Next came some questions and answers. This is great but it would be nice if there were some comprehension questions relating to the paragraph... there is nothing in the text that makes the student form their own Japanese sentences. In terms of the way the book looks: I found the images strange and disjointed. They seemed out of place in a Japanese book. Most people were not Japanese! I am also not drawn to the cover at all unfortunately. This could have been better. I would not recommend this book for learners of Japanese. It needs some more to it in my opinion.

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
