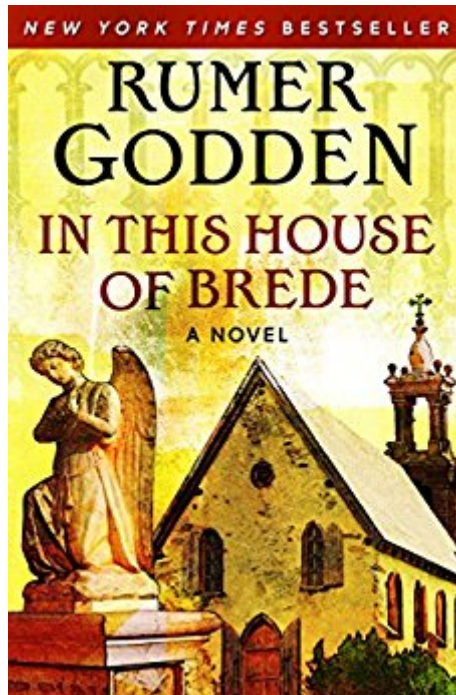

The great novelist Rumer Godden is hard to characterize. She wrote children's books, novels set in India, and novels about the life of cloistered religious, which are astonishing for their detail and arcane knowledge--that which only someone who had spent time in a convent or monastery would know (how did she come by this information? Turns out she lived for three years at the gate of an English abbey and thus, per conversations and observation, obtained insider, detailed knowledge of life behind the cloister gates.)This book is said to be better than some autobiographies of former

nuns. I believe it. The story is very complex and the main character shifts from one character to another: the Lady Abbess, who dies soon after the story, her successor who finds out her former Abbess' dark secret, a novice who leaves a heartbroken suitor behind, a group of Japanese girls sent to found a sister house, and many others. The sisters torment each other, achieve mastery of great arts, suffer, and struggle with their spiritual life in the most interesting and complex situations. One story builds on another--making this one of those novels hard to put down.
