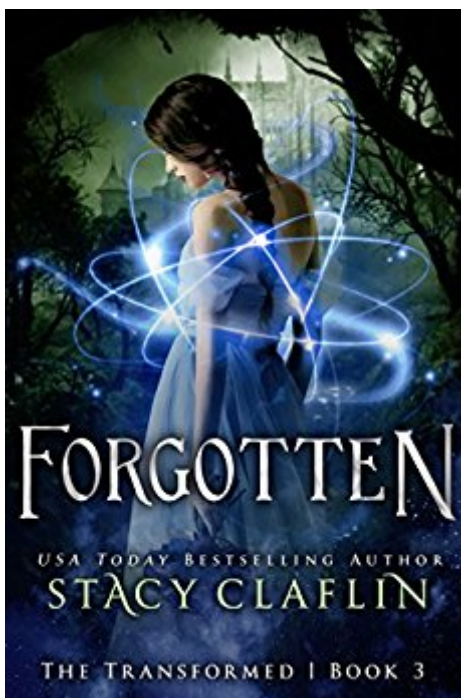


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# Forgotten (The Transformed Series Book 3)
