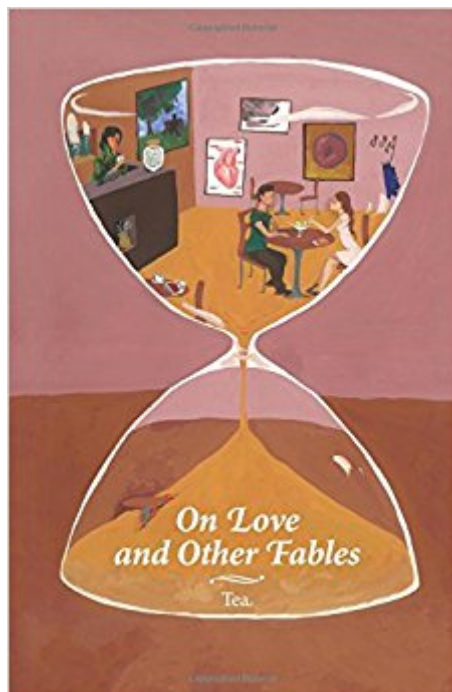

I have read Tea in Hebrew and now have the pleasure of reading him in English. Tea is a man who can weave a fabric out of words not only with great mastery, but with delightful timing. I loved the diverse range of style: some of the shorter stories are sweetly romantic with the air of teenage love

about them, and some of the longer ones are deep, at least IMHO, presentations and interpretations of the human condition. Some of them I have just enjoyed, while others have made me contemplative. This is a good read for anyone who wishes to get a unique view of, indeed an instruction in - the matters of love and loss. I recommend it wholeheartedly.

I found this book while looking for Fables or short stories. I figured this could be an alternative to Aesop's book of fables. I've got about 20 pages left to read, but I love the author's writing and the emotion he puts into his tales. Toward the back of the book he switches it up and one of the longer stories had me laughing out loud. Great read and would recommend to anyone who enjoys short stories that inspire thinking.

Tea is a master of language. If there are feelings at sleep within you, feelings of longing, or nostalgia, or pain, memories that you want to revisit and examine again, this book is perfect. It woke within me emotions that I have not had the pleasure of experiencing in a long time. Warning: this will make you cry.
