

There are many editions of The Big Book out there, and it has been revised several times, but this 75th anniversary edition contains THE ORIGINAL 1939 TEXT that laid the foundation for the tenets of Alcoholics Anonymous written by co-founders Bill Wilson and Bob Smith ("Bill W" and "Dr. Bob") with aid by Lois Wilson and Henry Parkhurst. This is the text that helped people understand that alcoholism is a disease.
