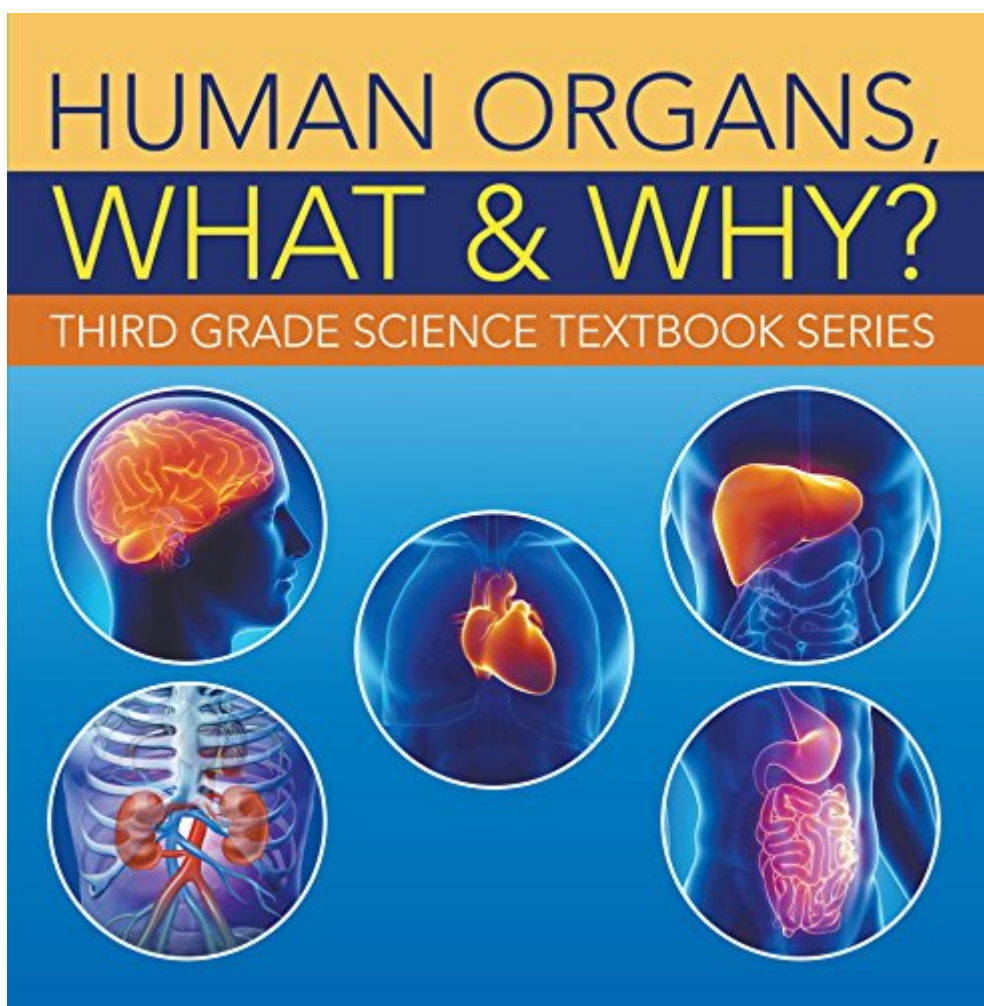

This book does not deserve to be called a textbook, much less a third grade textbook. I teach a special education science class. Even though I teach in a high school, the ability level of my class ranges from 3-5 grade. I thought this would be a good addition to my curriculum. The descriptions were too high for even my student's abilities and there wasn't much explanation of any of the content words or their interactions with each other..
