

If your partner is unwilling to speak to you about it, it leaves you out in the cold as to what you should do next - even if just for yourself. It clearly states you should not leave, but doesn't tell you what you should do. I also was looking for some information that would help me determine if I am enabling the gambling, but that subject did not get covered either.
