

This book covers the thorax, abdomen and pelvis, but not the neck/head. Many items in each picture are labeled, but not all anatomy that one might be interested in. There is an overview picture that shows which part of the body the CT slice is referring to, but a few of these are wrong (the slice shows one notch down from the indicated location... it seems that the index image is the same as the one on the facing page, which is one notch higher). Still, a good reference to help you get oriented.

Great book for studying for the CT registry. The practice exams are challenging. I haven't sat for my test yet but this book is worth the money. Read, read, practice, practice!!!
