

A typical Fullerton novel. The battle scenes are long, carefully detailed, very believable and very exciting. I enjoy naval fiction, and especially small craft and ships. While WW I is not the era I enjoy reading about most, this book is one of Fullerton's best.

As usually Fullerton knows his stuff. Good story weaved in historical facts. Young officer's problems between superior officers and other ranks are one part of the story, after Nic gets his own command he sees the situation from a new angle. I am no expert of Zeebrugge raid so I cannot say anything about it.

This author has the ability to place you in the middle of the actual thrust and counter thrust of one of the most heroic episodes in the history of the English military. I was surprised when I reached the end of the book. I was that enthralled.
