

This is so unbelievable true. I live near Seattle and have seen it here. It's a racket. The book

mentions Commissioner Carlos Velategui, but he has new accomplice right across the hall, Henry Judson. Both have favorites who are allowed to charge huge fees (thousands to tens of thousands a month) while other guardians charge \$300-\$900 per month. My girl friend's mother was under guardianship there and the lawyer/guardian charged over \$400 an hour just to talk to her mother. Her mother couldn't afford the once a month check up the guardian made let alone the horrendous fees to pay her bills and see she had health appointments. How would you like to pay \$2000 to have your guardian accompany you to the doctor's office once. That's what they did. They charged \$150 an hour to file her paperwork. Guardianship is supposed to be for protecting the vulnerable from predators, but the judges take a percentage (or get favors) and OK the exploitation so that the guardian cannot be prosecuted. I've heard of other horrid cases in the Seattle (King county Superior) court also. So sad and so true.
