

His first effort,Â ª The Hunt for Red October, sold briskly as a result of rave reviews, then catapulted onto the bestseller list after President Ronald Reagan pronounced it the perfect yarn. Clancy was the undisputed master at blending exceptional realism and authenticity, intricate plotting, and razor-sharp suspense. He died in October 2013. Martin H. GreenbergÂ ª was honored in 1995 by the Mystery Writers of America with the Ellery Queen Award for lifetime achievement in mystery editing.
