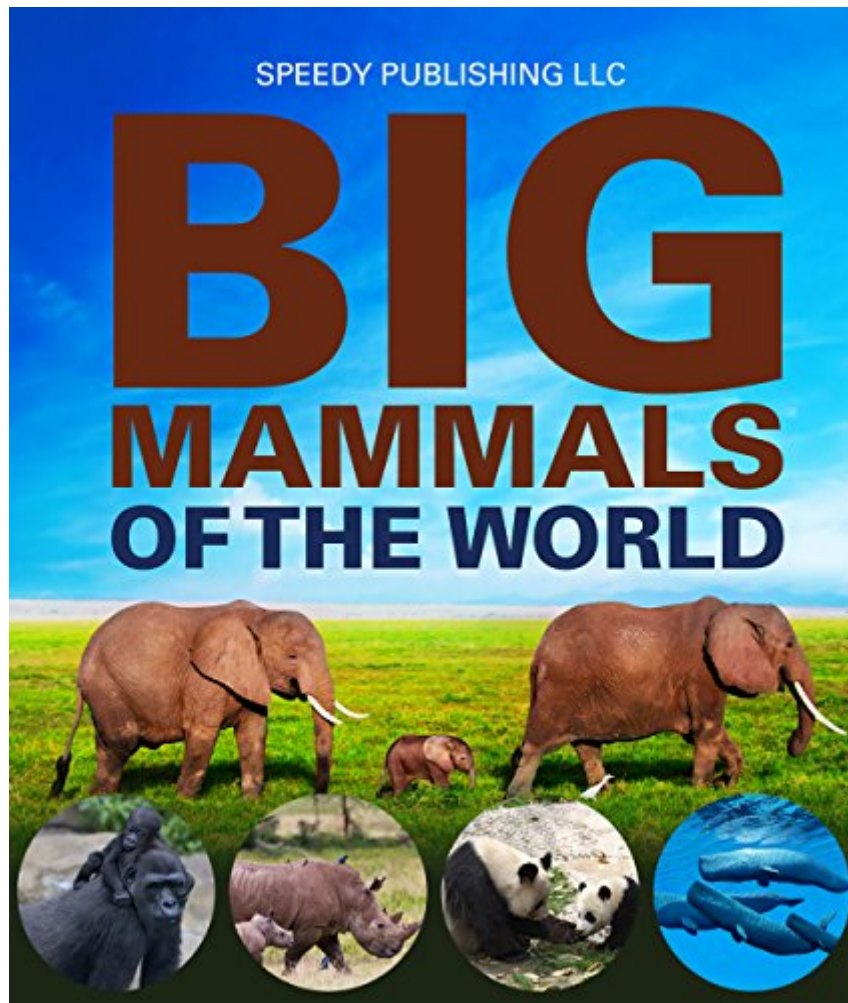




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Big Mammals Of The World

My 17 month old has recently taken an interest in anything to do with animals, so when I saw this book, I decided to give it a try so I could read/show it to him. Overall, I am pleased with the book especially given that right now, it's free. Pros:- It has 50 pages of mammals and mammal facts. The facts are short, but it's intended for children, so that's ok.- The pictures of mammals are close up shots. Some of the books I've been reading to my son show the animal at a distance, or with other animals. This book, however, shows each animal solely so your child can easily distinguish which

animal it is. There are land-based mammals and sea-based mammals in this book, so I have an array of different mammals to show/teach my son.- It's a super easy read. If your kids are like my son, they're constantly throwing a book in your lap to read. I can zip through this book in about 4-5 minutes flat, getting it out of my son's blood for about an hour.Cons: (none. for the price, you really can't gripe about this book)To my 17 month old son, this book is awesome as he can see many different animals/mammals in a different light from his other animal books. I would recommend this book to any parent looking to entertain their child with something other than a television.

The pictures of large mammals in this "Big Mammals of the World" Kindle Edition book by Speedy Publishing are very beautiful and enjoyable to look at. There are also a lot of facts about the mammals. I ordered this Kindle book to share with a 2-year-old, a 3-year-old, and an almost 6-year-old. When reading it with the toddler and preschooler, we look at the pictures together and I tell them what the picture is of. Sometimes I will throw in a small fact for the preschooler. However, when I read it with the almost 6-year-old, he is one who loves facts and learning information and he actually remembers it all quite well. So with a little bit of variance, this book can actually be for many different ages. Each of these children can and did enjoy the same book. The only thing that I did not like about this book was that the format was not always the same. Sometimes the picture was first and then the information. However, at times, the information was first and then the picture. It just makes it easier to "read" the Kindle version to the younger children, who I am just naming the mammals for. Again, we all enjoyed this informative book full of very well-done pictures.

This book has a lot of nice pictures which my children really liked. The use of the word "extant" on many of the descriptions and fact pages about the animals was a bit crazy for children. It is a word not many adults other than scientists could probably define. It just means still in existence. I would have used the phrase "alive today, or found today" rather than extant. The information about the animals appeared to be correct even when the grammar was a bit iffy. The kids did not care about that because I did not read it incorrectly to them. Overall, the book is informative with a lot of nice pictures that the kids liked. That is more important than correct grammar. They enjoyed it and one wanted to use it for a book report so she has it on her Kindle now. Another wants it added to his so I am going to do that as soon as I finish the review. I would say this book is not for very young children unless you are just showing them the pictures. The information and background given for the animals would not be of interest to them. Giving them the idea that these are very large animals is

probably enough. I received this book free in exchange for my honest review.

Even though I am an adult, I still love to read books about animals, even books that are intended for children. When I saw this for my Kindle for free I knew I wanted to read it. I have read a lot of the other Speedy Publishing books and have enjoyed them too. This was a very entertaining book. The pictures were great and the facts about them were also interesting. Most facts about each mammal included how tall and long they are and how much they weigh. This had a good variety of large mammals including some marine mammals. I think that it is great to have children understand that not all animals that live in the water are "fish." This was a short book and an easy read. I think this would be good for children of most ages. The pictures alone should keep even a two year old entertained. I would recommend this book to anyone. Usually books we have encountered just state the weight which makes it hard for my kid to compare because really, how many kids do know how much 2 or 2000 pounds really is - but they do know a truck weighs a lot.
